Inspired by this year's *One Read* book, "The Tortilla Curtain" by T.C. Boyle, the theme for this show is the immigrant experience. Entries may be in any two- or three-dimensional media.

Submit your artwork by Monday, September 18 to any Daniel Boone Regional Library facility or bookmobile stop.

Selected entries will be displayed Friday, September 22 at the Cherry Street Artisan in downtown Columbia, at the Columbia Festival of the Arts September 23 & 24, September 25-October 2 at Westwood Coffee at 319 W. 4th St., Fulton, and on the library's Web site. The show will be juried. The library retains the right not to display works inappropriate to the theme or setting.

Cut out and attach a contest participation form (below) to the back of your entry. If submitting a photo, you will need to include a subject release form (available at <http://oneread.dbrl.org>) completed by each person in the photo.

Two-dimensional works should be matted or mounted but need not be framed.
